There are **240,000** water main breaks a year in the U.S. and **650** breaks a day<sup>1</sup>

**7 billion** gallons of water are lost each day<sup>2</sup>

Our nation's water infrastructure received a D- on its 2013 report card<sup>1</sup>

## **INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENTS**

Drinking water infrastructure will require at least **\$1** trillion in investment over the next 25 years<sup>3</sup>

By 2035, **16,000-20,000** miles of aging pipes will be replaced each year <sup>1</sup>







Communities in the U.S. with public-private partnerships save customers 10%-40%<sup>4</sup>

Public-private partnership contracts were renewed within the private water industry nearly 97% of the time from 2000-2015

Privately owned water utilities have been serving America for over 200 years<sup>6</sup>
