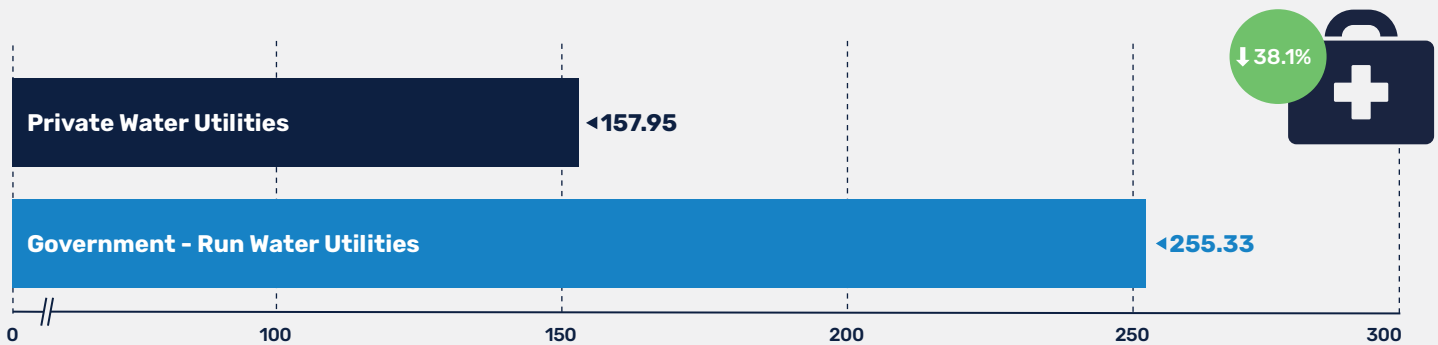


AMERICA'S WATER COMPANIES = SAFER WORKPLACES



Private sector water utility workers are less likely to get injured on the job compared to utilities run by local governments. Federal data shows a **38.1% lower rate of injuries and illnesses** for private water utility workers compared to municipal workers between 2013 and 2022.
